
Encouraging parents/carers to attend the 'Help Your Child Love Maths!' workshop

We've put together some tips to help you encourage parents/carers to attend the 'Help Your Child Love Maths!' workshop. These ideas have been collated from past schools involved in the project.

- Coincide the workshop with another event that parents/carers are already attending.
- Provide refreshments.
- Run multiple workshops at different times of the day to suit working parents.
- Ask children to create invitations to encourage parents/carers to attend.
- Ensure parents/carers understand that the workshop will not involve them doing any actual maths.
- Provide the opportunity for parents/carers to visit their children before or after the workshop.
- Liaise with the PTA/Parent Governors/class representatives/Family Liaison Officer to promote the event.
- Provide childcare for workshops hosted out of school hours.
- Run a raffle that parents/carers are automatically entered into if they attend.
- Make sure all staff, including SLT, are aware of the workshop and can promote it to families.
